We've made it through another winter and it's now officially spring! With a few rainy days, we'll be rid of the accumulated salt and road grime that keeps us off the roads. I'm guessing that some folks have already pulled the car covers off and fired up their cars for the first time in months. I haven't yet, but should be able to do that soon.



The cruise scene looks promising this year, and likely a little bit different. The Norwin Shopping Center cruise on Saturday nights was resuscitated by Bob Massie Toyota after being declared “finished” last fall. According to carcruises.com, Bob Massie's funding the DJs and paying the liability insurance. This cruise still lists quite a few rules— no alcohol, no burnouts, no solicitations, and so on – so be on your best behavior when you attend! The first cruise at the Norwin Shopping Center is April 29th, the same day as the Downtown Irwin Main Street Car Cruise that a number of our members attend every year.

The Wexford Starlite Car Cruise on Friday nights at North Way Christian Community Church continues this year, starting the Friday before Memorial Day. It will be interesting to see how this cruise shapes up going forward – the church sold some property at the front corner of the parking lot, across Route 19 from the Sheetz, to Chick-Fil-A for construction of a restaurant there. It's hard to imagine that won't take away at least a couple of hundred parking spaces in a lot that already gets extremely crowded for the cruises. On top of that, you'll have the construction equipment and dirt, and once the restaurant is complete, the extra traffic to contend with. The Starlite Cruise is always looking for volunteers to help and only gets support from a couple of local car clubs, which is one of the reasons they keep the season short, finishing on Labor Day weekend.

Victory Church in Cranberry Township is supplementing the Starlite cruise with several Friday night cruises in April and May, starting April 21st; skipping June, July, and August, then holding four Friday night cruises in September. This cruise is on Route 19 just north of the YMCA, and the Church has a very large parking lot, a DJ, and usually some food vendors on hand. They must not want to compete with the Starlite cruise, but when Starlite's not on, the Victory Church cruise has been very well-attended on Friday nights.

There are a lot of other local cruises on carcruises.com; some big, some smaller, so if you're looking for a cruise, you can probably find one almost any night of the week. Hopefully we'll get a lot of participation and see a lot of our members this year!



GTOAA Chapters:

The Gateway and Heart of Illinois GTO Clubs have planned two historic Route 66 Cruise-Ins into the 2017 GTOAA National Convention in Springfield, Illinois where your members will have the opportunity to travel along sections of the Mother Road, Route 66. Both Cruise-Ins start at 9:00 am on Tuesday, June 27th and both will arrive in Springfield, Illinois Tuesday afternoon.

Ken Braun and the Windy City Goats will begin in Bolingbrook, a suburb of Chicago and head south along historic Route 66 with stops in Dwight, Odell and Pontiac where cruisers can visit the Pontiac Oakland Museum. After lunch in Chenoa you will cruise through Shirley, Atlanta with a stop at the Palms Café and then on into Springfield.

Jeff Bond and Dan Jackson will begin the St. Louis Cruise In on the west side of the historic Chain of Rocks Bridge. The Gateway GTO Club has arranged to have the bridge opened and allow you to drive your GTO or Pontiac across this piece of Route 66 history that opened in 1929 and closed in 1970. Cruisers will continue north to Staunton and a visit to the Rabbit Hutch then on to the Turkey Tracks and a real section of the original brick Route 66.

Bring your cameras as there are many great photo opportunities with your GTO or Pontiac in front of some historic Route 66 landmarks.
